



Safety Requirements

As a member, you are to operate club aircraft in accordance with US Army Airfield rules and regulations, local flying rules, Coleman Aero Club standard operating procedures, and US Federal Aviation Regulations. Deviation from these rules and regulations is grounds for immediate termination from the Coleman AeroClub.

As a member, you are required to attend at least one safety meeting per quarter. Safety meetings are on the first Saturday of each month in conjunction with the monthly membership meeting. November through March, the Safety/Membership meeting will begin at 1100. April through October, the Safety/Membership meeting will begin immediately following the wash and wax. You are welcome to attend each meeting if the subject appeals to you or if you would like to bring up a point at the Membership Meeting. If you are unable to attend a Safety/Membership meeting once a quarter, you will be placed on the “No Fly” list. You are then responsible to schedule a “make-up” briefing with the Safety Officer or BOG member at \$16.50 per hour. Once you have been briefed, your name will be removed from the “No Fly” list.
